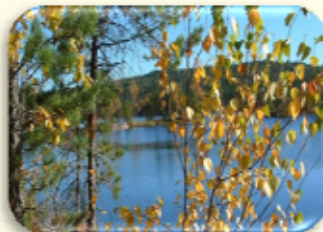


Why attend?

Course Schedule:

The course is run over 2 x 3 day modules and includes:

- Continuous assessment against the ICF competences
- 1 hr formal practical coaching assessment
- Written exam
- Psychometric assessment.

A certain level of knowledge is assumed and this includes; contracting and boundaries, transactional analysis, the GROW model, basic question technique, Meta and Milton model.

Course content includes and is not limited to;

- Introduction to coaching, the ICF Core competences and code of ethics
- Coaching and therapy; similarities and difference, return on investment.
- Coaching teams and groups
- Accreditation to use the iWAM psychometric tool
- CLEAN Language and clean cards
- Creative coaching including sandplay, story cubes and more
- Current research in coaching
- Continuous development for coaches

Once we have closed the group attendance we will finalise the agenda according to the needs of the majority of the group.
